

Welcome to the Monthly Tracker for Scotland's Housing First Pathfinder.

Scotland's Housing First Pathfinder is led by cross-sector partnerships in Aberdeen/shire, Dundee, Edinburgh, Glasgow and Stirling. The Pathfinders are leading while learning how to scale up Housing First on a local authority-wide basis.

This tracker summarises headline progress at **31 January 2020** with richer outcomes data following soon.

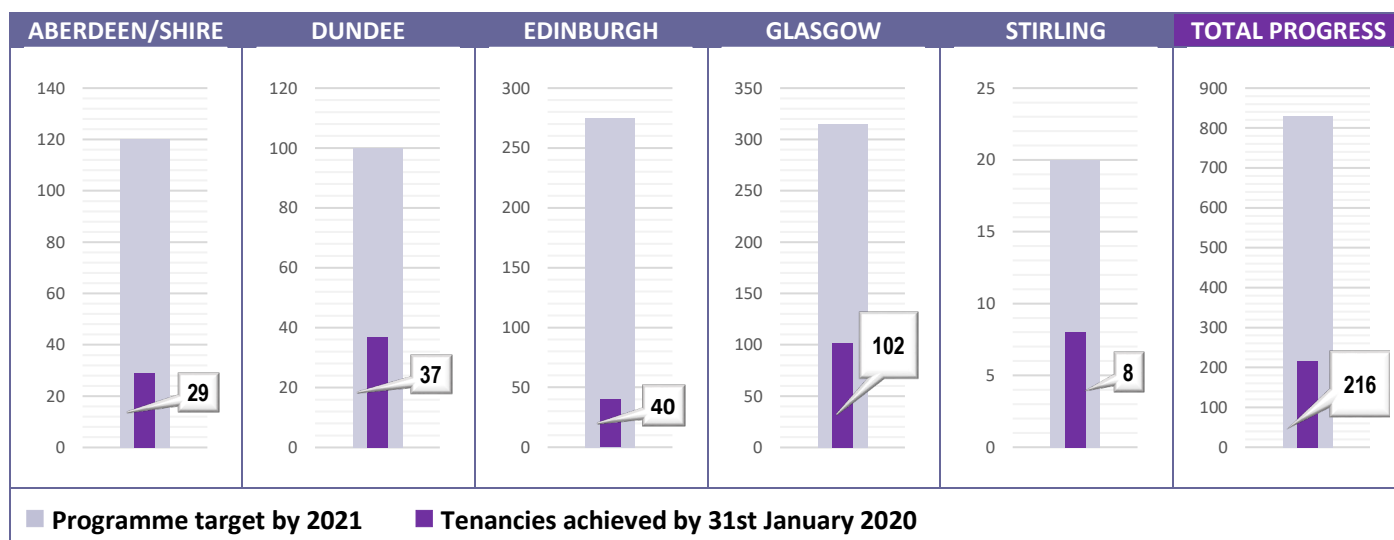
KEY POINTS

- The number of people moving into a Housing First tenancy in January 2020 was **25**, the highest monthly total to date. This brings the total to **216*** people moving into their own homes across the Pathfinder, and sees Glasgow pass the **100** tenancy milestone.
- **199**** people continue to sustain their tenancies, which equates to a **92%** tenancy sustainment rate.
- For tenancies beginning in January the average length of time before moving in was **139** days bringing the average time for the Programme to date to **103** days.
- To date nobody has been evicted from their tenancy.

* The numbers in the tracker have been revised in line with updated local reporting

** This month two existing tenants moved in together, affecting calculations for the total number of tenancies. To incorporate this going forward we will now report on the number of people in Housing First tenancies.

Catalysed by Social Bite and Scottish Government, the Pathfinder is managed by Corra Foundation and Homeless Network Scotland and funded by Scottish Government, Social Bite and Merchants House Glasgow.
