

Welcome to the Monthly Tracker Report for Scotland's Housing First Pathfinder Programme

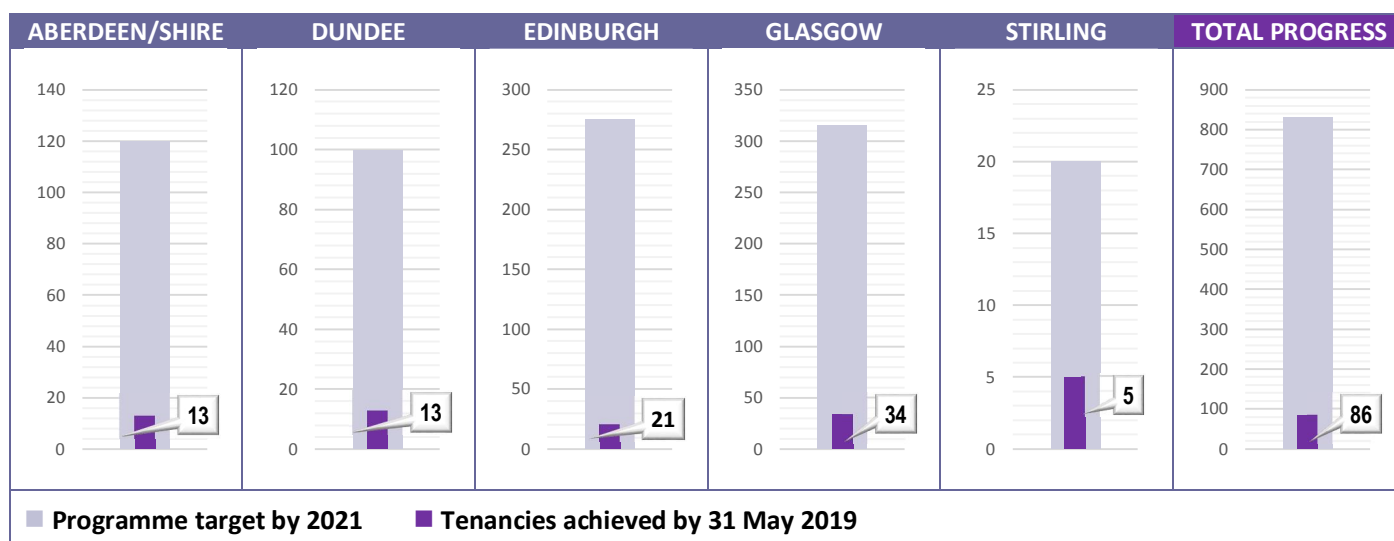
830 Housing First tenancies will be provided for people in Aberdeen/shire, Dundee, Edinburgh, Glasgow and Stirling by March 2021. The quarterly guidance targets below accumulate to reach this total within timescale. Progress toward those targets at 31st May 2019 is shown below:

KEY POINTS

- The number of new Housing First tenancies started during May 2019 was **16**, the most tenancies created in a single month so far. This brings the total for the Programme to **86***.
- For tenancies beginning in May 2019 the average length of time before moving in was **83** days, and the average time for the programme to date is **69** days.
- The number of tenancies sustained so far is **86** - **99%** of the total tenancies started. 1 tenancy ended in March 2019 as a result of a planned move to protect the person's safety.
- No tenancies have ended so far as a result of eviction or abandonment.

* The total number of tenancies to date has been revised in line with updated local reporting.

Housing First Scotland belongs to everyone who is helping Housing First become the first response for people whose homelessness is compounded by experiences such as trauma, abuse, addictions and mental ill health. It is hosted by Homeless Network (GHN), set up in partnership with Turning Point Scotland and I-SPHERE at Heriot-Watt University.

Scotland's Housing First Pathfinder is led by multi-agency partnerships in Aberdeen/shire, Dundee, Edinburgh, Glasgow and Stirling. Catalysed and funded by Social Bite and Scottish Government, it is managed by the Corra Foundation and Homeless Network (GHN). The Pathfinders are leading Scotland's first local authority-wide scaling up of the Housing First approach.
